Growing Hope provides free therapy for children and young people with additional needs in partnership with local churches. We also support parents, carers and siblings through our support groups. Our schools training offers teachers and support staff the opportunity to gain practical advice from therapy professionals:



Attention & Concentration Training – Find out about sensory processing and practical strategies to support attention and concentration in the classroom.



Teacher Surgery – A practical Q&A session where teachers can bring questions around children's participation and needs in the classroom.



Lunch & Learn – A 30 minute training session on strategies to support attention, handwriting & fine motor skills over lunch.



Handwriting Training – Find out about supporting children with their writing development at all ages and stages across school.



Policy & Planning – A consultation session with department leads to support specific policy e.g. handwriting policy, PE programme.



Disability Awareness – A session which can be given in disability awareness week explaining Developmental Coordination Disorder, Autism or other diagnoses to students or staff.



Function, Fitness & Fun Workshop – Tips and ideas for supporting physical development for children in the classroom and PE.
