

Growing Hope Champion Volunteer Role Description

Growing Hope is a charity providing free therapy for children and young people with additional needs in partnership with local churches across the UK. We aim to grow hope for children, hope for families, and hope in Jesus. We currently have four Growing Hope clinics: King's Cross, Brockley, High Wycombe and Gateshead. We provide support groups for parents and siblings of children with additional needs through our clinics as well as offering facilitator training to support the wider community. We also support churches through accessibility training and our award scheme.

Champion Growing Hope by spreading the word in your local community, whether that is a church, workplace, school or other community setting.

A Growing Hope Champion will be expected to:

- Share information about the clinic provision and connect local families with the free services available at Growing Hope clinics.
- Promote the Growing Hope 'clinic' main fundraising event and campaign each year within your setting
- Organise at least one local community fundraising event to support the growth of Growing Hope (e.g. cake sale, quiz night, Christmas giving).
- Encourage your local church to pray for the ongoing work of Growing Hope.

Tasks for this role will be more flexible, with the volunteer manager working together with the Champion to create a tasklist.

We ask our volunteers for a minimum commitment of 6 months.
