We currently have eight Growing Hope clinics: King's Cross, Brockley, High Wycombe, Maidstone, Redbridge, Solent, York and Farnham. We provide support groups for parents and siblings of children with additional needs through our clinics as well as offering facilitator training to support the wider community. We also support churches through accessibility training and our award scheme.
